5. PUBLIC COMMENTS (3 minutes per speaker)

Commissioners Blackmon and Forte joined the meeting at 2:03 PM.

Cindy Darrah, on behalf of Saul Simolunas, President of the Chemist Union argued that members of the National Register for Environmental Chemists are being kicked out and the ones without credentials are being retained.

Mable Mays, 5044 Kensington, stated the Department owes her \$370.00 from fourteen months ago. Ms. Mays was referred to a customer care representative.

Kelly Kade and Mike D'Agostino, Banyan Investments, 8109 E Jefferson, claimed water was shut off at their property on a Saturday without notification. He argued his account is in current status. They have three commercial spaces and two residential tenants. Ms. Kade and Mr. D'Agostino were referred to the Manager of the Customer Service Group.

Nick Delicata, ND Property Management Inc, 205-211 W Congress, argued against the Department's change in policy regarding Fenkell lines. Darryl Latimer, Chief Customer Service Officer, replied that Fenkell lines have multiple accounts feeding off one water line. If a bill becomes delinquent (in shut off status), the Department has to discontinue service for multiple dwellings - the tenant and everyone on that water line. The Department does not allow tenants on Fenkill lines to enter into landlord-tenants agreements - the landlord is responsible because there is only one point of access. Mr. Delicata was referred to a customer care representative.

Brigitte Howard, 9561 Bryden, argued the commercial building she owns has high sewer charges. Ms. Howard was referred to a customer care representative.

Haider Aljeborj, 17245 Mount Elliott, stated he purchased a lot December 13, 2013 from Wayne County. Mr. Ajeborj asked for help to minimize his \$30,000.00 bill in order to sale the lot versus letting the property revert back to Wayne County, which would not benefit the city. Mr. Ajeborj was referred to a customer care representative.

Behrouz Rashidinejad, 20200 Clark Rd in Belleville, stated a building he owns at 9260 Freeland in Detroit has a water bill of \$42,015.00. Each month, he said, the sewer portion is \$1,980.00. He requested help lowering charges. Mr. Rashidinejad was referred to a customer care representative.
