

# DETROIT WATERfund

While many DWSD customers have the financial ability to make their monthly water payments, other customers need a helping hand. United Way for Southeastern Michigan and the City of Detroit are joining forces to establish a single water support fund to help those customers who want to pay their bills. It's a way to help them catch up on overdue bills and stay above water.

**If eligible, the fund will pay up to 50% of your unpaid balance and 25% toward future bills**

## BALANCE



Have an outstanding balance of between \$300 and \$2,000.

## USAGE



Maintain Average Water Usage for their household size.

## INCOME



Be a Detroit residential water customer and have an active DWSD Payment Plan Agreement.

Be enrolled in DTE's Low Income Self-Sufficiency Plan (LSP); or, have income at or below 150 percent of the federal poverty level (for example, a family of 4 must have an annual income below \$35,775).

Customers previously enrolled in the DWF that defaulted out of the program may re-apply immediately without penalty.

If these statements apply to you, you can apply to Detroit Water Fund to receive help.
