DWSD DIRECTOR EXPRESSES CONFIDENCE IN SECURITY CHIEF

Detroit Water and Sewerage Department (DWSD) Director Sue F. McCormick today expressed confidence in the performance of Chief Security and Integrity Officer W. Barnett Jones after local media published a story that Jones had also been under contract by the City of Flint that continued after he had started his position at DWSD.
